

CYBSA Coach Reminders

- Managers and coaches are responsible for the return of all equipment. Check Event calendar for return date and time.
- Seek volunteer / assign a Team Mom or Dad as soon as possible. Send Team Mom to the Team Mom meeting. See [Team Mom page](#) for date and time.
- T-ball (4-6) and Rookie (7-8) games will use parent volunteer umpires. Each team provides one (1) umpire per game.
- Only children Officially roster-ed on your team are allowed to participate in practices and games.
- All Babe Ruth League rules and CYBSA Supplemental rules are in effect, any questions concerning rules should be directed to your age division VP or CYBSA Operations Manager Randy Seifert (720) 249-7696.
- Players, Managers, Coaches and spectators should not challenge judgment calls made by umpires.
- Managers and Coaches are responsible for checking the field / area after the team has finished. CYBSA does not have "Lost and Found" for items left behind by players and spectators.
- Please have your players pick up all trash in and around the playing field **prior** to leaving the field.
- SAFETY IS THE MOST IMPORTANT ASPECT WHEN COACHING YOUTH!!!
PLEASE STRESS TO THE PLAYERS THE NEED TO KNOW WHERE THE BALL IS AT ALL TIMES.
- Carry your first aid kit to all games and practices
- Reassure and aid children who are injured, frightened, or lost.
- Provide, or assist in obtaining medical attention for those who require it
- **Know your limitations**
- Assist those who require medical attention - and when administering aid remember to:

LOOK for signs of injury (blood, black-and-blue, deformity of joint, etc.)

LISTEN to the injured describe what happened and what hurts if conscious. Before questioning, you may have to soothe an excited child.

FEEL gently and carefully the injured area for signs of swelling or grating of broken bone.

DO NOT

- Administer any Medications
- Provide any food or beverages
- Hesitate in giving aid when needed
- Be afraid to ask for help if you're not sure of the proper procedures
- Transport injured individuals except in extreme emergencies
- **Leave an unattended child at a practice or game.**
